

How to Protect Birds from Window-Strikes

One hundred million to one billion birds die each year due to collisions with human built structures. Glass is an invisible killer-25% strike window.

Following are 10 methods to reduce bird collisions with windows. (Window-strikes)

- 1) Hang window works of art
- 2) Use netting
- 3) White wash
- 4) Multiple use of stickers
- 5) UV Liquid
- 6) Feeder 1.5' or closer to window
- 7) Close curtains
- 8) Move house plants away from window
- 9) Films-Opaque windows
- 10) Etched glass

Bird Collisions are due to:

- Lack of vision
- Reflection of outdoors
- Define territory

Other ways to prevent window-strikes:

- Keep shades down
- place moving objects near windows
- Have feeders in front of windows
- Place bird baths and feeders 1-3 feet from windows
- Place additional bird baths 35-30 feet from windows
- Awnings
- Save time-Don't wash the windows
